JOHN BURKE WINS STEPHEN ARRIGAN CUP IN MULLINGAR

At the European Youth Olympics held in Mullingar at the week-end, John Burke put in an outstanding performance in the final stage on Sunday. This was a gruelling 50-mile road race with 52 of the best under-age riders in the country competing. John won the hotly contested uphill sprint finish to capture the Stephen Arrigan Memorial Cup. He finished in four place overall for the two days. He missed out narrowly for a trip to Holland.

On Saturday, John also showed great form in finishing in 5th place. Two other D. H. Burke C.C. riders, Stephen Burke and Tomas Joyce also put in a very good performance.
